3 (a) The objects to be pursued by the company on its incorporation are:

To undertake, promote and implement social welfare, charitable, educational, health, environmental, women empowerment, child welfare, youth development, senior citizen welfare, disability support, livelihood generation, rehabilitation, counselling, awareness, skill development, community development, disaster preparedness, disaster management, emergency response, relief, rescue, rehabilitation and post-disaster recovery programmes for the benefit of society without providing residential accommodation.

To establish, manage and operate counselling centres, day-care centres, training centres, helplines, rehabilitation programmes, outreach activities, community support services, welfare projects and other social service initiatives for children, women, elderly persons, differently-abled persons, victims of disasters, economically weaker sections and other vulnerable groups; and to undertake correctional, reformatory, rehabilitation and reintegration programmes for individuals in need of care, protection and social support, without residential facilities.

To establish, promote and manage membership-based associations, forums, clubs, federations, networks and organizations for promoting social, educational, cultural, environmental, consumer awareness, public welfare and community participation; and to organize seminars, workshops, conferences, awareness campaigns, volunteer programmes, research, capacity-building, disaster risk reduction, emergency preparedness and relief coordination activities for achieving the objects of the Company.

(b) *Matters which are necessary for furtherance of the objects specified in clause 3(a) are

1. To implement, run, manage, and execute works, programs, campaigns, and projects, whether for the Central Government, State Government, or semi-government bodies (including local bodies), corporations, companies, societies, bodies corporate, firms, or individuals.
2. To set up, open, maintain, or operate vocational training centers for the purpose of training deserving persons with respect to the main objects of the Company.
3. To apply to the government, public bodies (urban, local, municipal, district, or otherwise), corporations, companies, or other persons for, and to accept, grants of money, equipment, land, buildings, donations, gifts, subscriptions, and other assistance with a view to promoting the objects of the Company, and to conform to the conditions on which such grants and payments may be received.
4. To appeal for, call for, request, and receive donations from any person, both within and outside India (subject to RBI guidelines), in pursuance of the objects of the Company; and to make, give, gift, contribute, or

donate funds to other charitable causes, persons, institutions, trusts, organizations, societies, and the Government.

5. To coordinate with government bodies, educational institutions, clubs, private entities, or non-governmental organizations to facilitate functions relating to the main objects of the Company.

6. To promote and encourage the field by making available the services of experts for consultancy; and to run, establish, and maintain libraries relating to the main objects of the Company.

7. To procure the Company to be registered or recognized in any part of India or in any foreign country or place.

8. To undertake and execute any trusts which may seem desirable, whether gratuitously or otherwise; to vest any real or personal property, rights, or interests acquired by or belonging to the Company in any person or company on behalf of or for the benefit of the Company, with or without any declared trust in favor of the Company, for the furtherance of its main objects.

9. To train or pay for the training (in India or abroad) of any of the Company's employees or any other candidates in the interest of and for the furtherance of the Company's objects and business.

10. To do all such other lawful things as are considered necessary for the furtherance of the above objects; PROVIDED THAT the Company shall not support with its funds, or endeavor to impose on or procure to be observed by its

members or others, any regulations or restrictions which, if an object of the Company, would make it a Trade Union.

5 (i) The profits, if any, or other income and property of the company, when-so-ever derived, shall be applied, solely for the promotion of its objects as set forth in this memorandum.

(ii) No portion of the profits, other income or property aforesaid shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise by way of profit, to persons who, at any time are, or have been, members of the company or to any one or more of them or to any persons claiming through any one or more of them.

(iii) No remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the company to any of its members, whether officers or members of the company or not, except payment of out-of-pocket expenses, reasonable and proper interest on money lent, or reasonable and proper rent on premises let to the company.

(iv) Nothing in this clause shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its officers or servants (not being members) or to any other person (not being member), in return for any services actually rendered to the company.

(v) Nothing in these clauses (iii) and (iv) shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudence remuneration to any of its members in return for any services (not being services of a kind which are required to be rendered by a member), actually rendered to the company
